Healthy Schools Week

During the week beginning 20th June, we will be having a number of events in school which promote healthy and active lifestyles. These are as follows:

Monday 20th June – Healthy Eating Assembly at 9.15am in the school hall. This assembly will be led by colleagues from Pulse, the company which provides us with sports coaching both during and after school. Parents are invited to attend. Following the assembly, children will take part in health-related activities throughout the day.

At the end of the day, there will be a **'Mums and Daughters' Zumba session,** to which all our mums and daughters are welcome to attend. This will take place from 3.30-4.30pm in the school hall.

Tuesday 21st June – Activity sessions will take place for all children in school, led by Pulse. The day will end with a **'Dads and Lads' football session**. All fathers and sons are welcome to join us for this session which will take place from 3.30-4.30pm on the school field.

Wednesday 22nd June – School Sports Day
