## The Big Sing Liturgy Thing

Next Thursday, 20th October, Year 6 will be attending the Big Sing Liturgy Thing along with 300 children from the other BKCAT Primary and Secondary schools, led by CJM Music. The children will experience working with a live band and musicians with a full, professional sound and light show. CJM also work closely with a Liturgical Dance company called More Than Dance, who have worked with our schools now for many years. CJM and More Than Dance, work together in the morning (the Big Sing) to teach the children the songs and dance moves to present a liturgy in the afternoon. The day will be a wonderful way to develop the children's spirituality in their first half term of Year 6, through taking part in singing and collective worship.
