#### **Class Newsletters**

As we begin the Spring term, each child will be coming home with a class newsletter from their teacher. This newsletter will outline what the children will be learning across the Spring term, and key information such as homework and PE days.

#### **Reward System**

On Monday Mrs Quinn shared with the children in assembly the new ideas for our new behaviour and motivation system in school. The children will be placed into 'House Teams' based upon the four elements of fire, earth, air and water. These were chosen by the children in a vote across school as our 'House' names. The children are very enthusiastic and are busy designing some characters to represent the elements for each team. I am sure they will share something about it with you. #### **Dinner Money**

To help Miss Tudor in the office please ensure that all dinner money is sent into school in a sealed envelope stating the name of the child and amount. The cost of dinner money is £2.20 per day.

#### Uniform

As we begin the New Year, may I take this opportunity to remind you of the uniform expectations. All children do need to have a pair of black pumps in school. These need to be in a good condition as they are worn indoors throughout the day. Children are not permitted to wear trainers, other than for outdoor PE. Children must wear sensible black shoes to school. Please also ensure that your child has a suitable warm and waterproof coat at all times. It is important that all items of uniform are clearly labelled. A number of children have returned with extreme haircuts or tramlines cut into the hair. This is not allowed as part of our school uniform policy. Ideally children with long hair need to have this tied back in a small hair tie.

#### **Fitbits**

Many of the children have got Fitbits for Christmas and have been wearing them in school. These are expensive items and should not be worn by the children in school.

#### **Parking**

Please could I remind you to be considerate of our local neighbours when parking, and to avoid double parking if possible along Beckbridge Lane and Cemetery Road. The school car park is for the use of staff only and should not be used to pick up or drop off children.

#### **Young Voices**

Last night a number of our children attended Young Voices at Sheffield arena. The children had a fantastic time singing with enthusiasm and demonstrating some amazing moves! They were great ambassadors for the school and their behaviour was commented upon by other schools who were sat near them.
